Environmental Protection Division Clean Vehicle Related Tax Credits - Electric Vehicle Charger	Commercial	Yes, select EV Series chargers (EV320, EV480, EV48G, EV48S, EV800, EV80G, and EV80S)	The tax credit allowed is 10% of the cost of the charger and its installation or \$2,500, whichever is less. The tax credit is available only to businesses. Individual homes do not qualify. A qualified charger is one that is rated greater than 130 volts and is designed to charge on-road vehicles. The charger must be installed in Georgia and remain in Georgia for 5 consecutive years.
